5. You will be required to write a one-page evaluation at the conclusion of your project if it is funded.
6. Project detail: Please tell us what you want to use the money for. Attach sheets to this form to make your application. You must use the following headings and write a narrative under each:
 - A. Outline of project with scope and goal(s)
 - B. Budget detail listing what you need to spend the money for (Item, Supplier, Cost)
 - C. Grade, age, number of students involved
 - D. Resources to be used or purchased other than materials
 - E. Community involvement
 - F. Time line with steps and dates
 - G. Short and long-term effects of your project
 - H. How will you determine the level of success of this project?
